

Cornish American Heritage Society Application for Cornish Heritage Certificate

Eligibility

Applicant must be able to prove descent from a Cornish ancestor by official records, one from Cornwall and one from North America. Copies of those proving records must accompany this completed application. The copies need not be certified. The proving records will be returned to you with the heritage certificate.

Instructions

Please complete, to the best of your ability, the pedigree chart that accompanies this form and the questionnaire below. Use extra sheets of paper to include, if known, the names of all children in the generations of the direct descendant, as well as those whom they married, down to and including your own family. If you have two ancestors born in Cornwall, who settled in North America, please complete a separate questionnaire for each of them. A certificate may include more than one ancestor (but not more than two) at no extra cost.

The data you provide will be a valuable addition to the history of the Cornish in North America and a source of information to members of your family for years to come. An index of the ancestors collected in this project will be made available in the future. The modest charge for the certificate helps CAHS raise funds for the Paul Smales Fund. Therefore, we request a check or money order payable to the CORNISH AMERICAN HERITAGE SOCIETY for US\$10.00 with each application.
